

I am in receipt of your correspondence dated March 18, 1981, concerning Resolution Number 134 wherein the City requests the placement of a Transit Shelter at the intersection of Elmgrove Avenue and Sessions Street.

As you are aware, the Rhode Island Public Transit Authority has entered into a contract with a private firm for the construction and maintenance of one hundred and fifty shelters to be placed throughout our system.
