

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 503

Approved August 11, 2000

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, That His Honor, the Mayor, is authorized to grant a non-exclusive sub-surface easement below Worcester Street in the City of Providence to the Providence Journal Company. Said easement shall be granted specifically upon the following provisions:

1. Said easement shall be utilized only for the installation and maintenance of conduit line fiber optic cable. Said easement shall not exceed an area twenty-one (21) feet by two (2) feet as the same is on the accompanying map marked as Exhibit A.
2. Said easement shall be used exclusively for the placement of fiber optic conduit which will provide card-reader access to a parking area located at or between Fountain and Worcester Streets.
3. Said easement shall be deemed to run with the land and shall operate against any successors in title and the easement or a memorandum of same shall be recorded in the Office of Land Records for the City of Providence.
4. Said easement shall be subject to a right of reverter/rights of reversion in the event that the situs of the easement is no longer utilized for the aforestated purposes. Also, they shall be for a term of not more than twenty (20) years. Additionally, Petitioner shall, at its own expense, remove said encroachment in the event the City notifies said Petitioner or any successor in interest thirty (30) days in advance of the intent of the City to utilize said realty for any purposes. By commencing any alteration pursuant to this grant, Petitioner specifically waives any claim for damages it may have for such use.
5. Any breakout necessary for installation and/or repair or replacement shall be resurfaced/rehabilitated to the approval of the Director of the Department of Public Works.
6. Any installation of utilities or utility lines shall be underground so as to preserve the public right of way.
7. Any installation of electrical mechanism shall be to the approval of the Director of the Department of Inspections & Standards.
8. The Providence Journal Company shall tender any prospective applicable street excavation fees and fees for underground utilities.

9. Petitioner shall ascertain that construction results in no adverse impact on any existing utility company and shall ensure the continued integrity of those existing structures and services.

10. The Providence Journal Company shall execute an indemnification and hold-harmless agreement with the City of Providence. Said agreement shall be approved by the Department of Law of the City of Providence.

11. The Providence Journal Company shall supply the City of Providence with an insurance policy naming said City of Providence, its agents, officers, servants and employees as additional-named insureds in a sum not less than one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00), which policy shall be approved by the Department of Law of the City of Providence.

12. Grantees shall not lay, construct or affix to the realty any temporary or permanent structure other than that described earlier herein.

13. Petitioner shall comply with all conditions contained herein not later than sixty (60) days from its approval. Upon failure to so comply for any reason, the within resolution shall automatically become a nullity.

14. Such other terms and conditions as may be reflected in the record and minutes of the City Council Committee on Public Property and/or as may be deemed appropriate by the Mayor or the Department of Law.

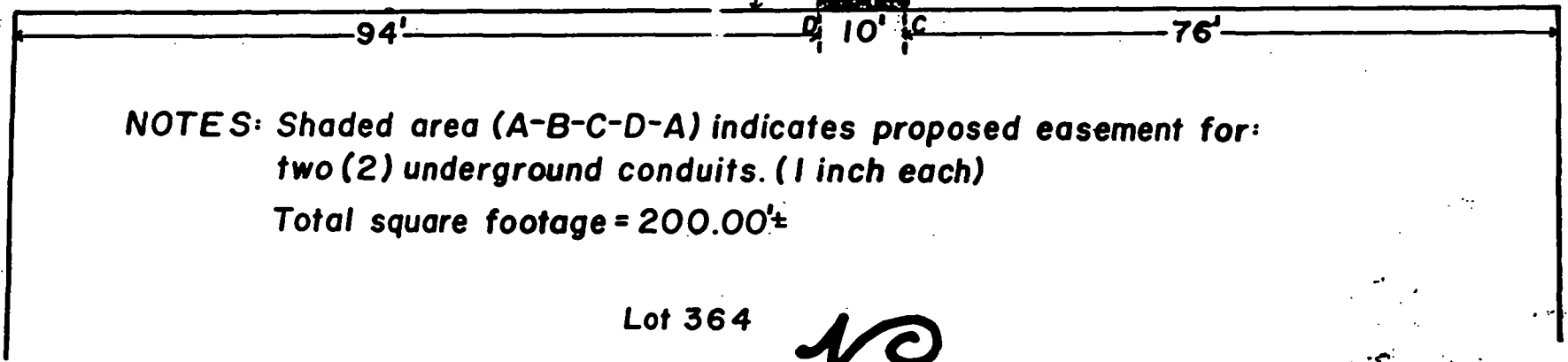

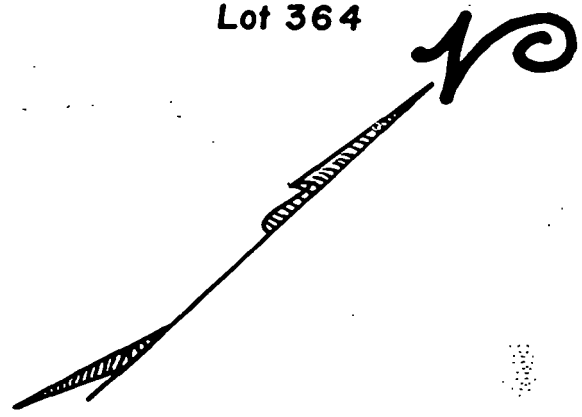


Dear Councilman Clarkin:

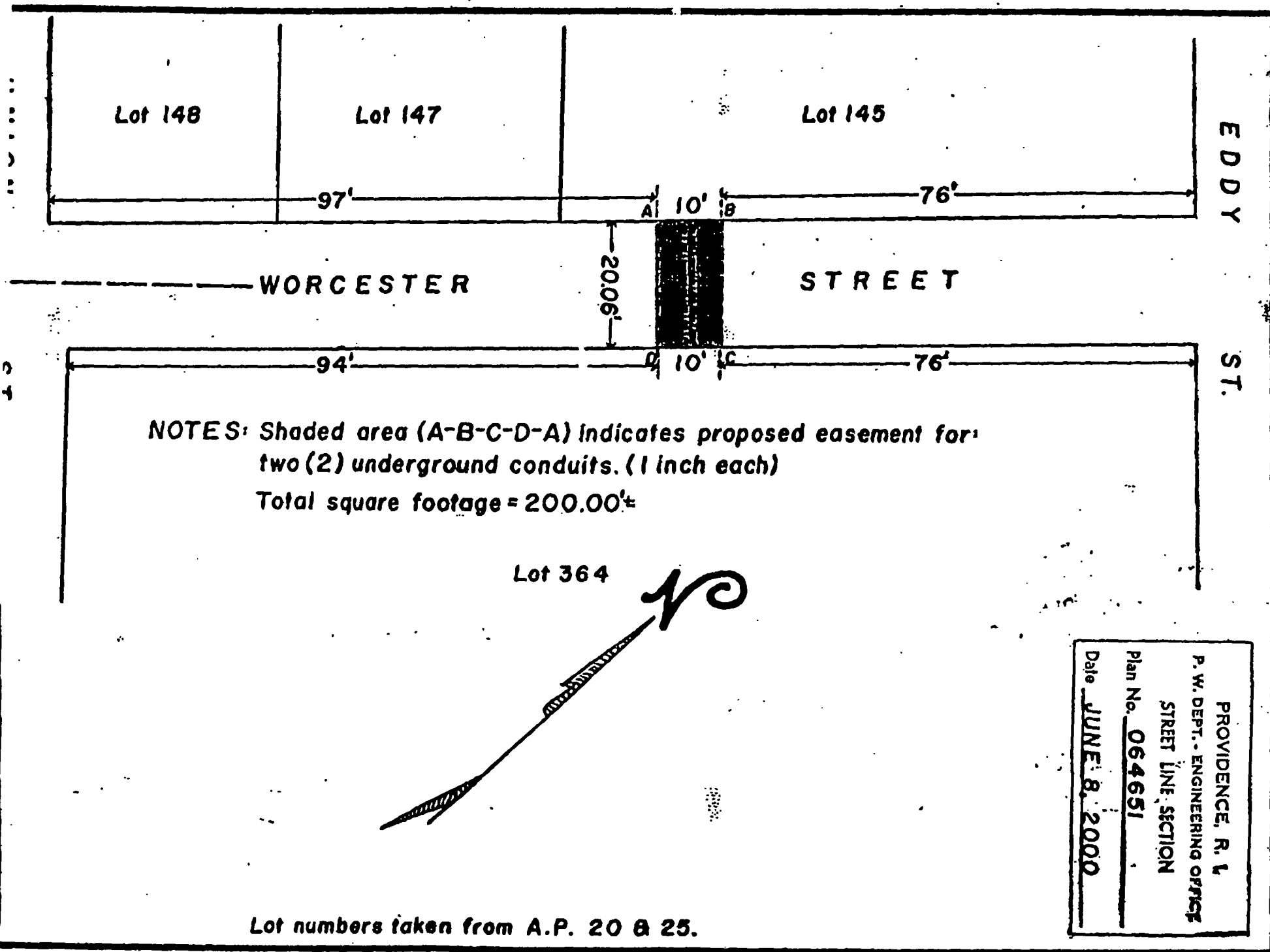

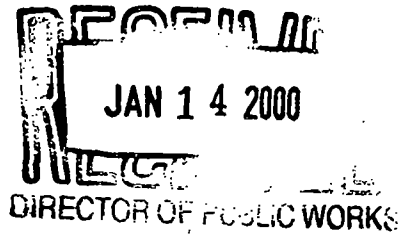
