PERSONAL SERVICES - This object code is for all general purposes the actual amount budgeted for annual payroll expenses. The total of \$162,276.00 represents a \$514.00 reduction from the previous years payroll account. This cutback was obtained by deleting a general foremans position while adding an urban forestry specialist position at a lower base salary.

SERVICES, OTHER THAN PERSONAL - The major portion of this object code is devoted to line item account #199 listed as miscellaneous services not classified. The allocation in item #199 for 1979-80 was \$39,000. This figure represents a \$6,000.00 decrease from the 1978-79 budget year. Although this 199 account is used primarily to obtain contractor services to assist city forces with tree and stump removals, this line item has also been utilized as a contingency fund to pay off outstanding debts, or to purchase new equipment should a surplus exist.

In the present fiscal year \$17,000. of this allotment was used to pay Bartlett Tree Expert Co., for emergency services rendered during the ice-storm of February, 1977. A tree-removal contract was funded with the remaining monies (\$22,000) in this item account.



## SERVICES, OTHER THAN PERSONAL - CONT'D.

Truck and auto repairs and an auto allowance line item accounts for the final \$2,565.00 budgeted to this object code.

**MATERIALS & SUPPLIES** - The line item accounts listed under this object code are geared primarily for shop supplies, tubes and tires for trucks and repair parts for forestry vehicles. There is also a line item for the purchase of trees & shrubs (\$1,800.00) within this object code. The total amount budgeted for materials & supplies for 1979-80 is \$9,490.00. This figure represents a \$140.00 increase over last years allotment.

**CAPITAL OUTLAY** - Funding for new equipment purchases or extensive repairs to existing equipment is provided for within the capitaloutlay object code. The 1979-80 allotment for capital expenditures was \$19,500 up \$4,500 from the previous year. The capital outlay funding was used this year to: (1) obtain a new 1980 Skyworker Model 1045 valued at \$28,500 through a lease-purchase agreement between the city and Rhode Island Hospital Trust Bank, and (2) to overhaul the engine of a 13 year old Forestry Skyworker. The former lease-purchase agreement will cost Forestry \$10,300 out of the 1979-80 capital outlay account. The latter engine repairs for the old skyworker will cost \$2,600.00.

**PERSONNEL & EQUIPMENT** - The number of employees working in the Forestry Division changed dramatically during 1979. The work force which began the year with a total of 21 full-time employees was reduced to 11 by the end of September. A cut back in the federally financed CETA program was chiefly responsible for this reduction in manpower. However, by years end, the work force had increased to 17 full time employees. Four Youth Corps positions financed by the federal government, were made available to forestry through the Department of Community Affairs, the state agency responsible for administering the program. Three parks employees who were transferred into forestry from the outside parks division accounted for the other increases to the work force.

The Forestry Division staff was augmented by the addition of one new administrative position in the 1979-80 budget. This new job was classified as an urban forestry specialist position. Although this position was created to delegate some of the duties ascribed to the City Forester, the urban forestry specialist is chiefly responsible for providing educational and technical assistance to the public as well as organizing local, state and federal urban greenery projects.

Two 1974 stake body dump trucks, a Ford/F-377 and an International M-200, did not pass Rhode Island safety inspection regulations in 1979 and were taken out of service after March 1, 1979. However, due to the acquisition of three (3) new vehicles, forestry work operations were not detrimentally affected by the loss of these two trucks.

Lastly, forestry has a current inventory of fifteen(15) Homelite, five (5) Stihl, One (1) Poulan and one (1) Partner gas powered chain saws.

EQUIPMENT PURCHASES - In March 1979, the Forestry Division received delivery on three new stake body dump trucks from Notorantonio Trucking, Inc., of No. Providence, R. I. These vehicles, which cost \$10,000 each, were paid for with funds in the 1978-79 budget.

Capital outlay monies were used in the 1979-80 budget to purchase a new Skyworker Model 1045, and to make extensive engine repairs to a 13 year old skyworker. The new skyworker was purchased from the Consolidated Utility Equipment Co., of New Hampshire through competitive bidding for \$28,656. Since the Forestry budget did not have this sum of money to cover the total cost of such an expensive item, a lease-purchase arrangement was established with Rhode Island Hospital Trust Bank and the City. The terms of the lease purchase arrangement between the bank and the city follow: Rhode Island Hospital Trust has agreed to finance this purchase over a 24 month period based on monthly payments in advance with a tax exempt rate of 6.75%. The two-year financing will require 24 payments of \$1,268.69 each with a total interest cost over that time span of \$1,880.59. Upon delivery of the skyworker from CUES, Inc., (arrival date is anticipated for February, 1980) a first payment to the bank in the amount of \$10,149.52 will be drawn from the Forestry capital outlay account for budget year 1979-1980. This total will cover eight monthly payments until the new budget year (1980-81) commences in July, 1980. The remaining debt will be paid from monies encumbered in the capital outlay account over the next 16 months (Fiscal years 1980-81, 1981-82).



## EQUIPMENT PURCHASES - CONT'D

A new engine was also installed into an existing skyworker during 1979. Since public works mechanics estimated the total cost of new engine repairs for this vehicle would exceed \$1,500, competitive bidding for these repairs were sought through the Board of Contract & Supply. The repair work was awarded to the Pascale International Inc. of Pawtucket, R. I., the lowest bidder at \$2,656.00. The skyworker has subsequently received a new engine and is back in service.

**WORK REPORT** - There were 254 potential work days during January 1 - December 31, 1979. The number of actual work days, defined as those days in which forestry personnel actually engaged in work related operations, totaled 219. The number of potential work days lost in 1979 were 35. These non-working days occurred as a result of either inclement weather or other unmitigating circumstances.

Absenteeism due either to sickness or other personal matters amounted to a loss of 352 men work days. This figure represents an increase of 33 lost men work days from the previous year. There was also a loss of 61 men work days from job related injuries in 1979. Down-time for equipment breakdowns among the entire Forestry vehicle force totaled 168 days. This figure for 1979 represents a decrease of 57 downtime days when compared to 1978.

The purchase of new dump trucks is probably the single most important factor that contributed to this substantial decrease in 1979. The amount of overtime hours issued in 1979 (1,244) was considerably less than the 2,010 in 1978. This significant decrease can best be explained by the fact that forestry experienced less emergency call back situations in 1979(28) than 1978 (53).

**TREE REMOVALS** - There were approximately 664 trees removed from public property under the direction of the forestry staff in 1979. Of this total, 546 trees were felled by city forces and the remaining 118 by private contractor. Although the overall removals total decreased by 36 trees in 1979 when compared to 1978 (700), removals by city forces increased by 18 over the same period. The number of trees removed by city forces translated into the disposal of 8,231 diameter inches, an increase of 3,010 inches from 1978.

The Bartlett Tree Expert, Inc., was responsible for causing the removal of 118 public trees at a cost of \$15,300.



## TREE REMOVALS - CONT'D

The average cost of these removals by private contractor was \$127.00 per tree. These removals were paid with city funds in the forestry budgets' miscellaneous services account #199.

As of December 31, 1979, there was an outstanding backlog of 71 public trees marked for removal.

**STUMP REMOVALS** - Approximately 696 stumps were removed on public property by city and private forces during 1979. Of this total, city forces were responsible for causing the removal of about 584 stumps, while the Bartlett Tree Expert Co., Inc. removed the remaining 112.

The city stump removals represents an increase of 414 over the 1978 total (170). The 584 stump removals translates into the disposal of 24,935 inches by city forces in 1979. The average size stump removed was 43" in 1979.

The total cost to remove the 118 stumps by private contractor was approximately \$6,238. This expenditure was paid with city funds in the forestry budgets' miscellaneous service account #199.

**MISCELLANEOUS** - Forestry personnel responded to approximately 344 requests by city residents for public assistance. A majority of these requests were of an emergency nature, and consisted of picking up fallen limbs or removing broken branches from street trees.

**TREE PRUNING** - Some type of pruning was performed by Forestry personnel on approximately 983 public trees in 1979. Out of this total 607 trees were pruned in response to citizen requests for public assistance. Special projects conducted throughout the city in 1979, accounted for the remaining 376 public trees that benefited from various pruning operations. These projects, geared toward public safety, involved the pruning of public trees located along Benefit, North Main, South Main, Thayer Streets, Morris Avenue, and Pleasant Valley Parkway.

Work records indicated that in 1979, 60% of all pruning operations was devoted to either cutting back (33.6%) branches from private property or raising up (27.4%) low limbs for public safety. Deadwood removal 16%, cosmetic trimming 15%, and street light clearance 3.7% constitute the other maintenance pruning work performed on public trees.

Overall, maintenance pruning operations were less productive in 1979 (983) than in 1978 (1307). Although there are many variables that may have contributed to this decrease, chief among these would have to be the CETA layoffs that cut drastically into the work force during the summer months.





TREE PLANTING - Tree planting in 1979 was limited to a few small projects scattered throughout the city of Providence. Urban renewal funds made possible the planting of london plane trees on Benefit Street and Atwells Avenue, and honeylocust and red maple trees on Westminster Mall. Also, 56 honeylocust trees were planted on Waterman Avenue under the auspices of the Mary Elizabeth Sharpe Street Tree Fund. Through private donations obtained from the community that are matched by the City Council, this organization has contributed over the years toward the planting of thousands of urban trees in Providence. The cost to furnish and install the 56 trees on Waterman Street was approximately \$9,700.

Finally, 12 honeylocust trees were purchased for \$1,200 from a local nursery with forestry funds and planted by city forces around Moorefield Plaza in the Silver Lake neighborhood.



## SUMMARY

The Forestry Division experienced a year of transition in 1979, when compared to 1978. Two main factors which came to overshadow other happenings during 1979, support this assessment. The first was the reduction of the work force as a result of the CETA layoffs commencing in June, 1979. In all twelve CETA employees, each with a minimum of two years service in forestry, were laid off between June and September, 1979. The loss of these individuals cut drastically into daily work operations since many of them had become quite adept at urban forestry skills during their tenure. The second was the complete lack of federal monies in 1979 as compared to the availability of funds used to finance many tree related projects the previous year. In 1978, tree pruning, removal and planting projects were conducted with federal monies made available through the Mayors' Office of Community Development and the Economic Development Act. However more stringent guidelines set by the federal government for the local allocation of community development funds has left many proposed programs in abeyance. Also, no federal funding similar to those monies supplied by the Economic Development Act in 1978 were in existence in 1979. The result was that forestry did not undertake any federally sponsored projects to improve the urban tree stock during the past year.

Overall, tree maintenance operations performed by forestry crews were much better than what might have been expected considering the unstable work force. Although pruning work totals lagged behind 1978 figures, tree removals were up slightly while stump removals increased dramatically in 1979. At years end backlogs of tree and stump removals were down considerably, while uncompleted pruning work remained quite high.

In conclusion the past year was one in which forestry officials focused more attention on daily work operations and in-house projects rather than the larger and more complicated federal projects of a year ago. This format in 1979 was influenced primarily by the absence of federal funds. However, despite the lack of funds and the CETA layoffs, work reports indicate that forestry crews were as productive in 1979 as they were in 1978.



## ABSTRACT & SUMMARY

The Forestry Division conducted a street tree survey in November, 1977. The survey results indicate that there are approximately 16,800 street trees **throughout** the city. Norway Maple is the most abundant tree species planted and accounts for 44% of the total tree population. Inferences drawn from the survey suggest that future tree planting programs should be designed around a 10% tree species maximum in order to reduce the disastrous effect of any future tree blight upon the total tree population.

Prior to the 1977 tree survey, there were no records on file, except for an Urban Planning Commission report issued in 1954, to provide any data directly related to the urban tree stock in Providence. In the report the Commission speculated there were approximately 50,000 street trees in various stages of growth by conducting land planning surveys with the use of aerial photographs. With so little information to rely on, it was almost impossible to avoid faulty trial and error decision making, poor planning and misallocation of financial resources in the even funding did become available for improved tree care. Therefore, forestry officials believed information gathered by the tree survey would be instrumental in outlining a plan for the systematic maintenance of street trees as well as providing the groundwork for a master street tree plan.

A street tree survey is a very useful tool that can provide valuable insights to help cope with the management of an urban forest. Specific objectives of the Providence survey were to determine:

1. the approximate # of street trees
2. the percentage composition of street tree species in the urban environment
3. the general status of street trees
4. the average tree height and caliper size of the urban tree stock
5. the extent of sidewalk maintenance problems as a result of street tree plantings.

To implement the survey a tool from traditional techniques used by foresters' in timber land appraisal was applied to urban street trees; using the techniques of plot sampling and analysis of variance approximately 10% of the linear street area within the city needed to be measure, and by the use of appropriate statistical techniques, an estimate within a 95% confidence limit was obtained. The size of the plots were each 0.4 miles long and measured by an **automobile** odometer. All trees lining



both sides of the street within the 0.4 mile long plot were measured ocularly to determine height. A tape measure was used to determine the trunk diameter at 5' from ground level. One-hundred random plot locations were chosen within the city boundaries with the use of a map, a grid coordinate overlay and a random number table.

When the data was gathered and finally analyzed the following salient facts of the survey were obtained:

1. that Providence has approximately 16,800 street trees with a valuation in the vicinity of \$14 Million Dollars.
2. Norway maple is the most abundant tree type and accounts for 44% of the total tree population. London plane 12%, Sugar Maple 9%, Pin Oak 5%, American Elm 4%, Honeylocust 3% and miscellaneous species 23% makes up the remainder of the total tree population.
3. Fifty-four % of the urban trees exhibited good health (0-15% dead-wood) and 21% poor (over 30% dead-wood) respectively
4. the average height and caliper size of a street tree measures 38 ft. and 11.4 inches respectively
5. A proximately 45% of the concrete and/or asphalt sidewalks contiguous to street trees exhibit an uplifting surface.
6. the survey indicates future tree planting programs should be designed around a 10% tree species maximum in order to reduce the disastrous effect of any future tree blight upon the total tree population.

The major obstacle to the effective management of city street trees is inadequate funding. This is evident by the fact street tree care and maintenance is but a small portion of the total municipal budget. The national median tree care budget as a % of the median total municipal budget is 0.5%.



To survive in the wake of streamlined budgets it is essential forestry programs become more efficient. The completed tree survey has proven to be a very pragmatic approach for establishing an effective tree maintenance program geared toward an orderly plan for the current and long range needs of planting, trimming and removal in Providence.
