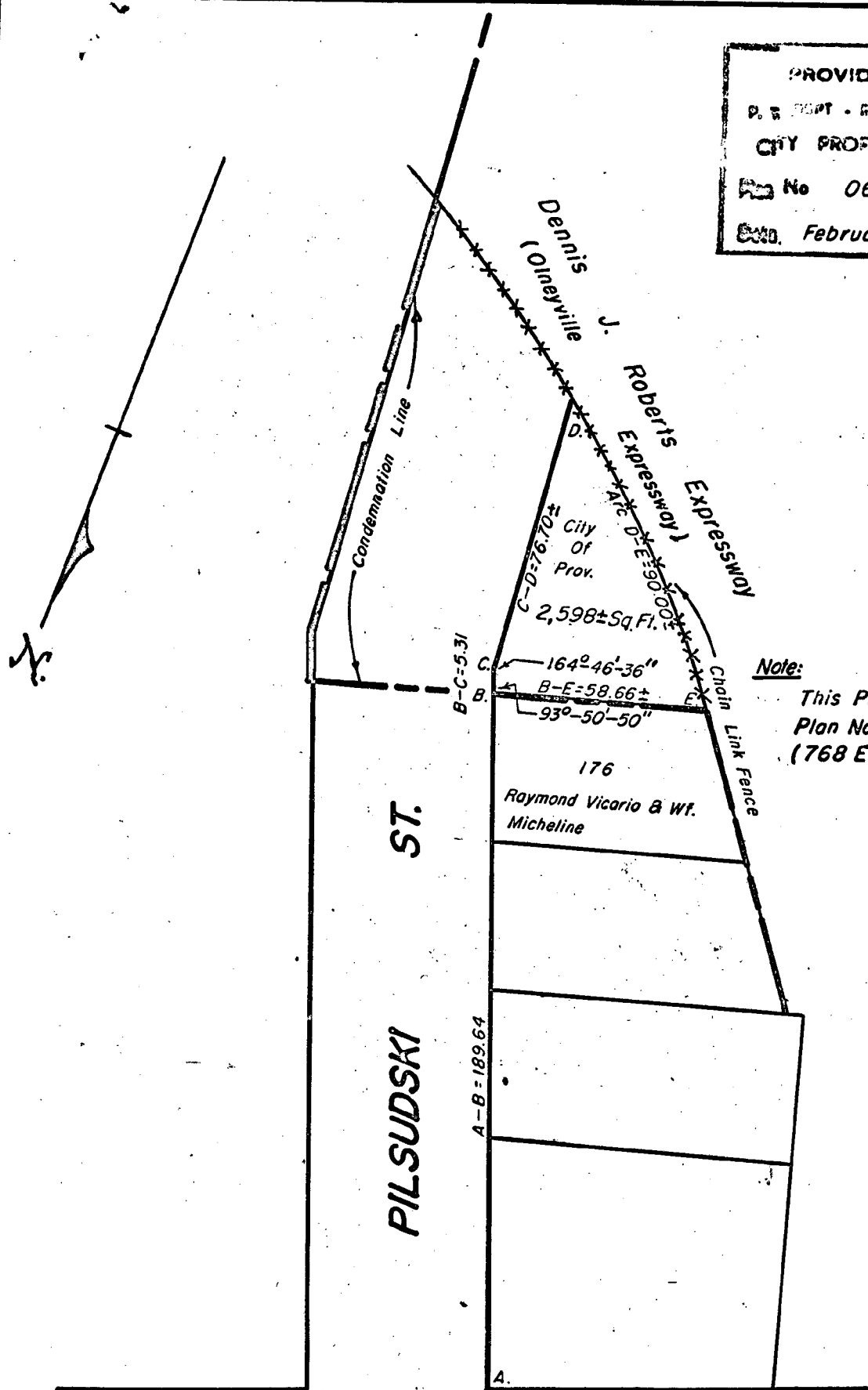

Approved May 24, 1968

RESOLVED,

That the City Treasurer, acting under the direction of the Committee on Finance, be and hereby is authorized and directed to borrow from time to time, in such sums as may be necessary, not exceeding Two Hundred, Seventy Two Thousand, Seven Hundred Seventy Three Dollars (\$272,773.00) in accordance with the provisions of Title 45, Chapter 32, Section 42, and Title 45, Chapter 33, Sections 1, 2, 4 and 17 of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, entitled, "Redevelopment Act of 1956," and to issue the City's notes therefor, signed by him and countersigned by the Mayor and the Chairman of the Committee on Finance and to renew any such notes from time to time as the same become due. The money thus obtained shall be used exclusively for carrying out the purposes of a Loan and Grant Contract between the Providence Redevelopment Agency and the Department of Housing and Urban Development of the United States of America for financing the Redevelopment Plan for the Mount Hope Project Area, designated as Project Number R. I. R-18.
