

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 418

Approved October 30, 1972

WHEREAS, the Roger Williams Park area is attended by a watchman during such time that the said Park is open to the public, and

WHEREAS, the said watchman, for the purpose of patrolling the Roger Williams Park area, employs his private vehicle, and if required to communicate with the Police Department, to register a complaint, must do so from a public telephone facility, which is time consuming,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that in order to afford more dilligence and faster notice of complaints when required, the Commissioner of Public Safety is hereby requested to consider the feasibility, and if determined to be so feasible, provide the Board of Park Commissioners with the use of a motor vehicle, equipped with a Police radio, for the purpose of aiding the intended purpose of this same watch patrol within Roger Williams Park.
