

# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 169

Approved February 20, 1953

Resolved,

That

effective immediately upon the removal of restrictions by the National Production Authority of the United States of America, the following named person, firm or corporation is hereby granted permission to erect, alter or use a building or structure at the location named herein for the sale of petroleum, kerosene, gasoline, coal oil and their products, compounds and components as described and shown in and on the application therefor and accompanying plat, all on file in the office of the Inspector of Buildings subject to the conditions that said person, firm or corporation shall not violate any of the laws of the State of Rhode Island or any of the Ordinances of the City of Providence relative to the erection, use or occupation of said structure and that said person, firm or corporation shall not allow petroleum, kerosene, gasoline, coal oil or their products, compounds or components, to be conveyed over or across any sidewalk by means of any pipe or hose, and upon such special conditions as are hereby enumerated, viz:

WARD 11. The Texas Company, 653 Broad Street and 2-8 Peace Street, Plat 44, Lot 273, replacing existing 4-1,000 gallon gasoline storage tanks with 2-3,000 gallon gasoline storage tanks making 8,000 gallons total capacity on the premises.

The erection or location of any buildings or structures not shown on the original plat on file with the Inspector of Buildings or any change in the location of buildings or structures from that shown on said plat shall be deemed a violation of this permit.

THERE WERE ABOUT 258 BLUE PRINTS & SPECIFICATIONS APPROVED FOR ARCHITECTS  
AND ENGINEERS, INCLUDING 890 ENGINEERING QUESTIONS TO SETTLE, OTHER THAN  
BLUE PRINTS, MAKING A TOTAL OF 1148 TECHNICAL QUESTIONS AND BLUE PRINT  
PLANS. THIS WORK WAS NECESSARY IN ORDER TO SEE THAT THE WORK TO BE  
CONSTRUCTED AND INSTALLED IN THE BUILDINGS, WOULD COMPLY WITH THE CITY OF <sup>174</sup>174  
PROVIDENCE PLUMBING LAWS.

#### COURT CASES.

THERE WERE 71, ILLEGAL PLUMBING AND DRAINAGE INSTALLATIONS THAT WERE  
CORRECTED AND LEGALIZED WITHOUT COURT ACTION, BY SENDING THE PARTY INVOLVED  
LEGAL LETTERS.

#### AGED AND CONVALESCENT HOMES.

THE SANITARY ENGINEERS DEPT, INSPECTED 7 HOMES FOR AGED AND CONVALESCENT  
PERSONS. THIS WAS REQUESTED BY THE STATE OF R.I. SOCIAL WELFARE DEPT, THE  
INSPECTIONS WERE REQUIRED UNDER THE R.I. STATE LAW CHAPTER 374, THE  
VISITS, AND INSPECTIONS MADE TO THE 7 HOMES BY THE SANITARY ENGINEER DEPT,  
WAS FOR THE APPROVAL OF THE LICENSE, OR THE APPROVAL FOR RENEWAL OF THE  
LICENSE, AND TO SEE THAT THE PLUMBING FIXTURES WERE IN GOOD WORKING  
CONDITION, THE NUMBER OF FIXTURES REQUIRED FOR THE HOME, AND IF IT COULD  
BE PASSED BY THIS DEPT, BEFORE THE SOCIAL WELFARE DEPT, ISSUED THE LICENSE  
OR THE RENEWAL OF THEIR LICENSE TO THE PARTY TO CONDUCT THE HOME.
