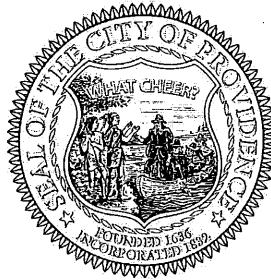

JEFFREY DANA'S LETTER - EXECUTIVE ORDER 20-05

Communication from Jeffrey Dana, City Solicitor, dated March 30, 2020, submitting his letter per Governor Gina Raimondo's Executive Order 20-5, issued March 30, 2020.

Per Governor Gina M. Raimondo's Executive Order 20-05, issued March 16, 2020, I advise the Council of the following:

The City Council is relieved from the prohibitions regarding the use of telephonic or electronic communication to conduct meetings, contained in RI General Laws 42-46-5(b), provided that it is meeting for an essential purpose and makes provisions to ensure public access to the meeting by adequate, alternative means. The Executive Order defines essential purpose as, "that which is necessary for continued government operations or to ensure compliance with the statutory or regulatory guidelines." This relief is in full force and effect until April 15, 2020.
