RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Approved March 27, 1980

WHEREAS, Traffic congestion on Spruce Street, from Acorn to Messenger Street, has become so acute; and

WHEREAS, Area residents have a difficult time finding parking during business hours; and

WHEREAS, The Federal Hill Businessmen's Association has requested that Spruce Street, from Messenger to Acorn be established as a One-Way Street; be it

RESOLVED, That Spruce Street, from Messenger Street to Acorn be established as a One-Way Street, in a westerly direction, and be it further

RESOLVED, That diagonal parking spaces for an additional fifty motor vehicles be painted, or so designated on Spruce Street.
