RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 121

EFFECTIVE ~~XXXXXXX~~ March 3, 1975

Resolved, that the General Assembly is respectfully urged and requested to enact legislation creating a road use tax to be levied against vehicles using Rhode Island highways as follows:

1. All road tractors and tractor-trailer trucks registered outside if the State of Rhode Island;
2. All trucks with more than two (2) axles;
3. Passenger vehicles for hire with seats for more than nine passengers, not including the operator; and

Be It Further Resolved, That the proposed legislation be similar in substance to comparable legislation enacted in the State of New York and the State of Connecticut; and

Be It Further Resolved, That the proposed legislation require the owners of all vehicles so taxed to purchase and display a tax stamp on an annual basis and submit quarterly tax reports to the Tax Administrator for the State of Rhode Island.

The City Clerk is directed to forward copies of this Resolution to all Members of the Providence delegation to the General Assembly within thirty-six (36) hours after passage and approved by the Mayor.

This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage.


