Dear Matt:

At the City Council meeting to be held on September 7, 1989 I intend to submit a resolution requesting that a portion of the median strip along Elmwood Avenue opposite the Furnace and Duct Supply Company at 635 Elmwood Avenue be removed. Representative Jeremiah P. Murphy wrote you on July 20 explaining the safety hazard caused by the median strip. It is my recollection that a City Council resolution is required before the state will act in this type of matter.

The City Council had also approved a resolution requesting that part of the median strip opposite the Stradford House Housing for the Elderly be removed so that the elderly could cross the street during the winter months without climbing over the mountain of snow created by the plows on the median strip. That request was denied based on budgetary considerations, but I cannot see why any great deal of money is involved. Only the width of the crosswalk would have to be cut out of the median strip. It also seems to me that a portion of the median strip should be removed opposite the Stradford House driveway. Currently the residents have to make a U-Turn to get on Elmwood Avenue headed toward downtown Providence.

As we have discussed in the past, there is a request to repave Elmwood Avenue between Roger Williams and Park Avenues and to remove the median strip from that area in the process. This area of Elmwood Avenue between the Reservoir and Roger Williams Avenues was resurfaced last year. I would eventually like to see the median strip removed entirely in this section also, but since the road was just resurfaced, I do not consider this a top priority.

I would appreciate your consideration in these matters.





In reference to your letter of September 12, 1989, we regret that we cannot accommodate the City Council's Resolution No. 432 pertaining to removing the raised median along Elmwood Avenue opposite the Furnace and Duct Supply Company.
