RESOLVED, DECREED AND ORDERED:

That the following named Rights-of-way shown as Cross-Hatched areas (A-B-C-D-E-F-G-H-J-K-L-M-A) on the accompanying plan entitled "Providence, Rhode Island, Department of Public Works- Engineering Office, City Property Section Plan No. 064019 dated May 13, 1977",

viz:

Lockwood St. from Prairie Ave. to Beacon Ave. and Beacon Ave. from Pearl St. to Oldham St. have ceased to be useful to the public and the same is proposed for abandonment.


ORDERED, That the Director of Public Works, be and he is hereby directed to cause a sign to be placed on the above-named Rights-of-way abandoned as aforesaid, having thereon the words "Not a Public Highway", and it is further

ORDERED, That after the entry of this order or decree the City Clerk shall cause a notice thereof to be published in a newspaper published in the County of Providence at least once each week for three successive weeks and a further and personal notice shall be served by the City Sergeant upon every owner of land abutting the above-named land which has been abandoned, who is known to reside within this State.


