



Dear Councilman Payne:

On July 15, we received a memorandum from the Department of the City Clerk dated July 8, 1966 in which was enclosed a copy of a petition to the City Council requesting the abandonment of a portion of Barbara Street from the westerly line of Middleton Street westerly to the easterly line of Celia Street. In checking our distribution plans, we find that there is a section of water main in that part of Barbara Street that is proposed for abandonment.

The depreciated value of the water main is \$224.61. We understand that this petition was filed by Donato DellaFave of 59 Celia Street, Providence and under the circumstances, we are filing a bill in the City Collector's Office covering payment to this department for the value of our facilities in the amount of \$224.61. We respectfully request that the Committee on Public Works withhold final action on this matter until we receive payment for the value of the water main.

SUBJECT: Referral No. 1559 - ABANDONMENT OF PORTION OF BARBARA STREET

Gentlemen:

The subject referral received consideration by the City Plan Commission at a meeting held on Thursday, July 28, 1966.

This referral is a request to abandon as a public highway that portion of Barbara Street from the westerly line of Middleton Street westerly to the easterly line of Celia Street, being a distance of approximately 200 feet.

On an inspection and photographic survey it was found that this portion of Barbara Street is completely unimproved and unused. The area surrounding is half vacant lots and half one-family dwellings. This street is of no use to the area and is an eyesore to the neighborhood.

VOTED: To offer no objection to the granting of this petition.

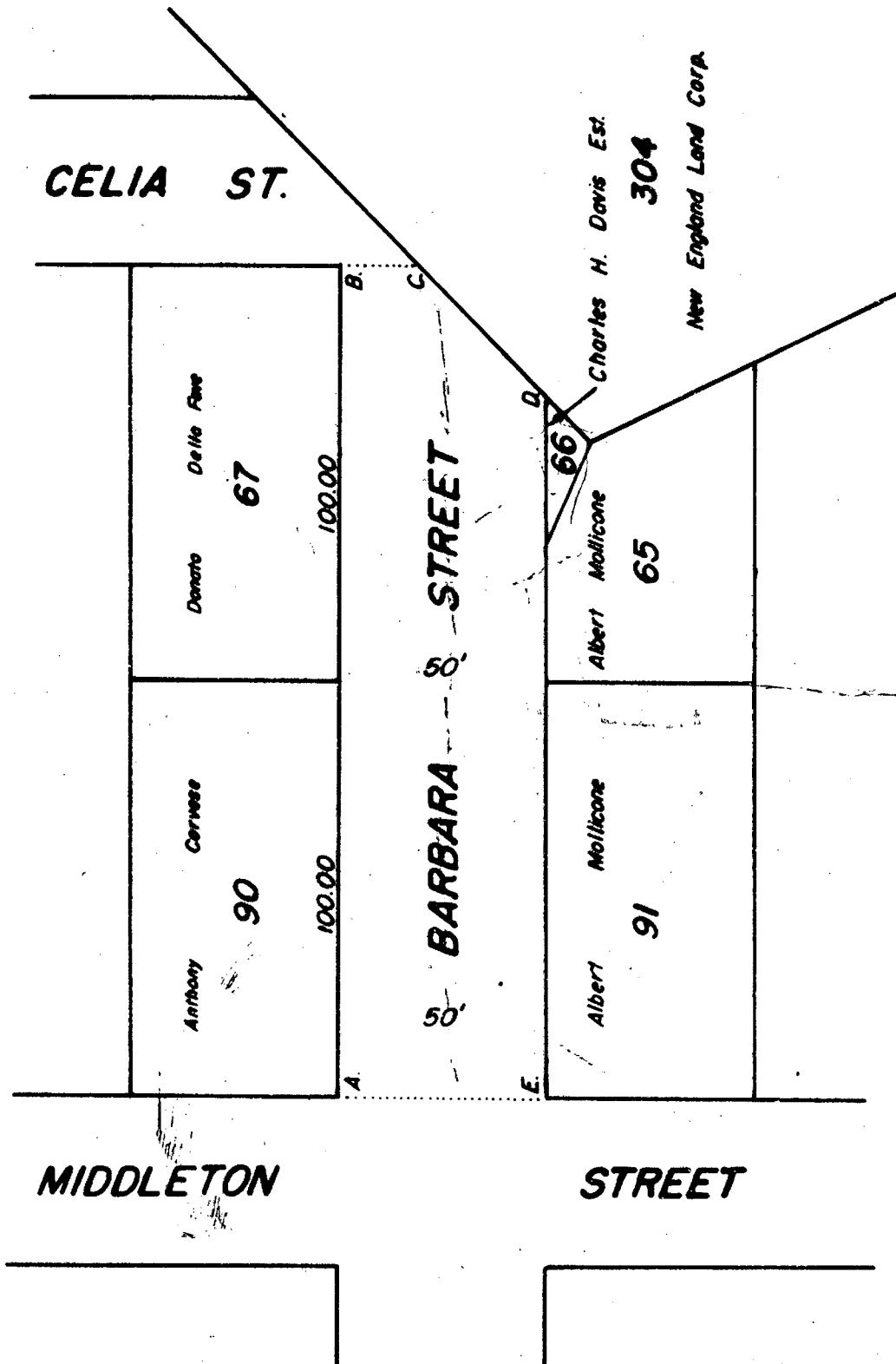

RESOLVED, That His Honor the Mayor be and he hereby is authorized to execute a deed of conveyance to the Rhode Island Wholesale Grocery Company of Lots 314, 192, 319, 4, 333, 332, 331, 330, and 304 on City Assessor's Plat 34, as of December 31, 1966, with a total land area of approximately Ninety Nine Thousand, Nine Hundred and Eleven (99,911) square feet in consideration of a purchase price of Thirty-four Thousand, Nine Hundred and Sixty Seven Dollars and Eighty Five Cents (\$34,967.85)

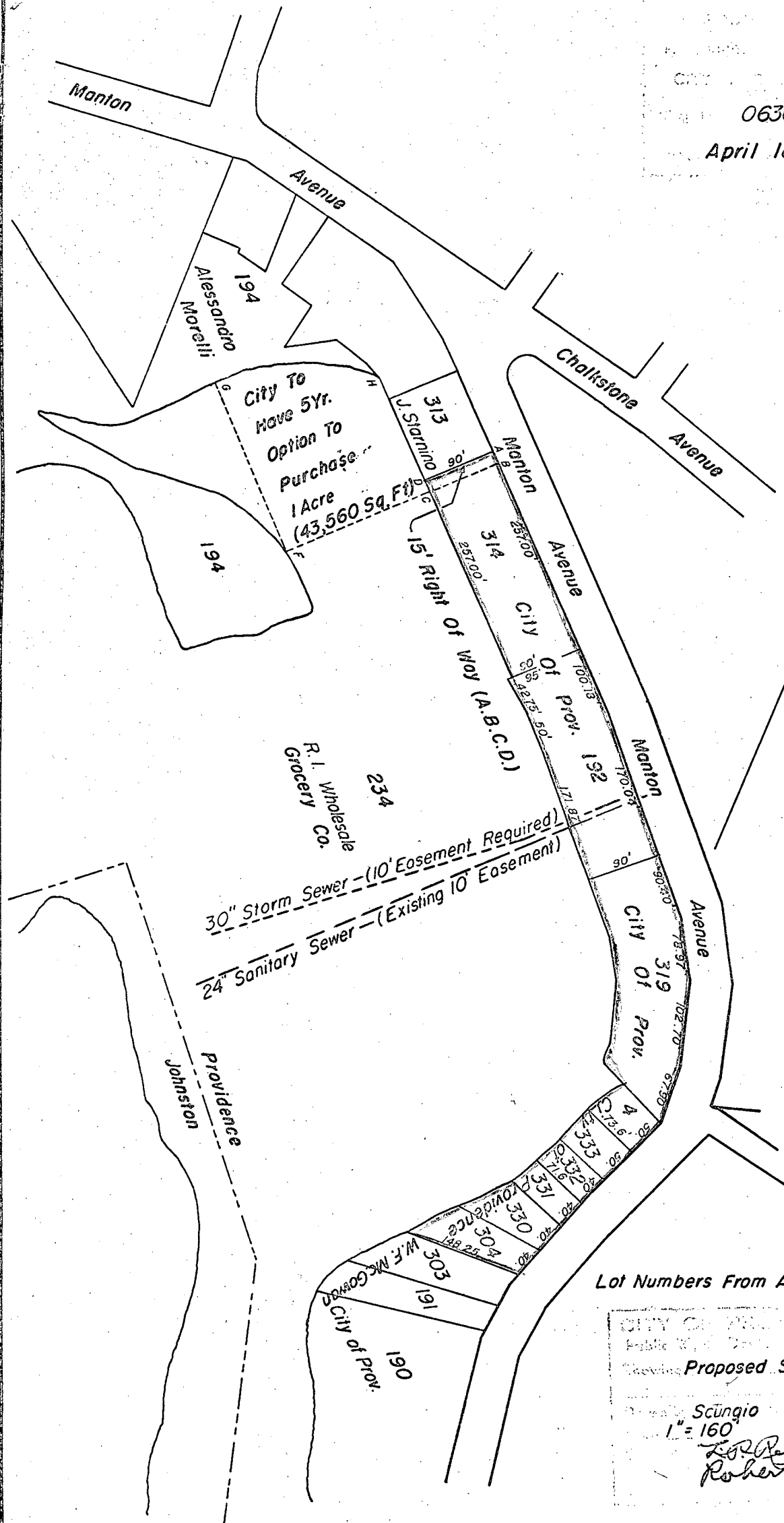
