Approved September 22, 1975



WHEREAS, there are a number of Senior Citizens of our City who have not, as yet, obtained Identification Passes, which would grant them the privilege of free public conveyance on buses of the Rhode Island Transit Authority, and


WHEREAS, the only place such passes may now be procured is at the State Division of Motor Vehicles, located in the State Office Building, behind the State Capitol, which is an inconvenience to such Senior Citizens,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that in order to accommodate those Senior Citizens of our community who have not, as yet, obtained Public Transportation Identification Passes, the Rhode Island Transit Authority is hereby requested to cause the same to be procured at more convenient locations, in the City of Providence, such as at Housing facilities for Senior Citizens; Clubs or Organizations or such, as may be equitable.
