

Dear Ms. Testa:

The 1994 Brown University Spring Weekend activities are slated for Thursday through Sunday, April 21st, 22nd, 23rd and 24th. I am requesting your assistance and approval for the following street closing which will assist in making the planned activities much safer due to the number of people in the area.

On Saturday, April 23, there will be special events taking place on the Main Green between 12:30PM - 2:00 AM. We are requesting to be able to close down George Street between Magee and Brown Sts. from 12:00 Noon until 2:00 AM, when the Concert ends. In order to accomplish this, I would post the area "NO PARKING" by 6:00 AM on Saturday, April 23; and at 12:00 noon close the block to vehicular traffic. "STREET CLOSED" signs would be necessary for this closing at George and Magee Sts. and at George and Brown Streets. Additionally, I would like to make George Street one way east between Brown & Thayer Sts., posting a DO NOT ENTER sign at Thayer & George Sts. prohibiting traffic from traveling west.

Additionally, on Saturday, April 23, I would like to post "NO PARKING" on the south side of Waterman Street between Brown Street and the Hope College Gate. In order to accomplish this, please post the area "NO PARKING" by 6:00 AM on Saturday, April 23.
