No. 387 **AN ORDINANCE** IN AMENDMENT OF SECTION
16-106 OF CHAPTER 16, ARTICLE III OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES
ENTITLED "NOISE CONTROL" AS AMENDED,

Approved July 12, 1999

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Article III of Chapter 16, Sec. 16-106 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Providence is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 16-106. Violations-Penalty.

Any person found guilty of violating, disobeying, neglecting, or refusing to comply with the provisions of this article, shall upon conviction be punished by a fine of not more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00), for any one offense, except that any person electing to appear before the clerk of municipal court and admitting the violation charged, or in lieu of personally appearing before the clerk of the court, electing to admit the violation by mail to the clerk of court, shall be punished by a fine of two hundred dollars. Provided, however, that for a second violation and any subsequent violation a person electing to appear before the Clerk of the Municipal Court and admitting the violation charged or, in lieu of personally appearing before the Clerk of the Court, electing to admit the violation by mail to the Clerk of Court shall be punished by a fine of three hundred dollars (\$300.00).

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
