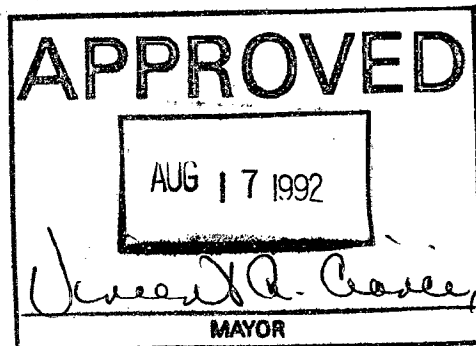

Dear Mr. Clement:

The State Traffic Commission (STC) during its September 23, 1992 meeting, considered the request of the City Council for the installation of crosswalks, where advisable on Smith Street in the City of Providence.

Smith Street begins on North Main Street running completely through the City to the Providence/North Providence border. This east/west corridor, which was once owned and maintained by the city, presents an engineering task which is beyond the limit of STC scope.

We suggest that the City Department of Traffic Engineering, through past experience, may be aware of individual problem areas which the STC can study. By copy of this response, the Traffic Engineering Department will be requested to provide locations along Smith Street where pedestrian studies may be undertaken.

Your request has been tabled in the meantime pending receipt of further information.
