AN ORDINANCE

FIRST DEPUTY CITY WEIGHER

CLASS TITLE: First Deputy City Weigher

CLASS DEFINITION: Performs routine work operating a platform scale; and related work as required.

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF WORK: Work involves responsibility for operating a platform scale, weighing such materials and objects as are presented. Work is reviewed occasionally for satisfactory performance. Supervision is exercised over one assistant.

ILLUSTRATIVE EXAMPLES OF WORK: Is in constant attendance at City scales and weighs trucks, tractors, trailers, passenger cars, and such materials and objects as are presented. Issues certificates of correct weight. Keeps records of work performed.

DESIRABLE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS AND ABILITIES: Ability to operate a platform scale. Ability to understand and effectively carry out written and oral instructions. Ability to keep records and make reports.

QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED FOR APPOINTMENT: Preferably graduation from a standard high school or trade school. Some experience in operating a platform scale.

USUAL LINE OF PROMOTION: From: Second Deputy City Weigher.

AGREEMENT PROVIDING FOR
SPECIAL BANK ACCOUNT FOR
LOCAL CONTRIBUTIONS
TOWARD COST OF FOX POINT

AGREEMENT FOR SPECIAL BANK ACCOUNT

This AGREEMENT is entered into by the City of Providence, represented by WALTER H. REYNOLDS, its Mayor, and the State of Rhode Island, represented by _____, its _____ hereafter referred to as the Local Interests and the United States of America, represented by Lieutenant Colonel Albert E. Saari, its Contracting Officer, hereinafter referred to as the Government.

Whereas the Government proposes to enter into a Contract for the construction of the Fox Point Hurricane Barrier, Providence, Rhode Island, hereinafter referred to as the Project, for the benefits of the Government and of the Local Interests, and

Whereas Public Law 85-500, 85th Congress authorizing the Project requires the Local Interests to contribute thirty percent (30%) of the first costs of the Project, and

Whereas the use of Government funds to finance the obligations of the Local Interests arising under the agreement to participate in the Project is unauthorized, thereby necessitating the expenditure of funds of the Local Interests, and

Whereas funds to be obligated on contracts and for hired labor in accomplishing the Project must be available to the Contracting Officer in an acceptable form, in the interest of making the necessary funds available to the Contracting Officer the Local Interests do hereby agree as follows:

1. To deposit in the INDUSTRIAL NATIONAL BANK OF PROVIDENCE (member bank of the Federal Reserve System) cash or negotiable securities with a market value of not less than \$440,000 which sum has been determined to be the estimated contribution required of the Local Interests during

fiscal year 1961 for construction plus such sums necessary for condemnation awards, the total contributions not to exceed \$1,640,000 for fiscal 1961.

2. That the Industrial National Bank of Providence will be authorized to liquidate the securities to provide for demand transfers to the Contracting Officer at such times and in such intervals as he may require.

3. To deposit such additional cash or negotiable securities with the Bank prior to the beginning of each fiscal year in an amount sufficient to meet the obligations of the Local Interests during each of the fiscal years for the duration of the construction period. Demand payments from the cash or liquidated negotiable securities shall be made to the Contracting Officer as hereinbefore agreed.

Now, therefore, the City of Providence and the State of Rhode Island acting through their respective representatives who are signatories hereto do agree to execute an irrevocable escrow agreement with the Industrial National Bank of Providence embodying the provisions hereinbefore enumerated.

The Contracting Officer agrees that upon ratification by Office, Chief of Engineers the cash or negotiable securities deposited under the escrow agreement shall constitute the equivalent of cash for the purpose of satisfying the financial obligations of the Local Interests arising under the agreement to participate in the project.
