### AN ACT

IN AMENDMENT OF THE "PROVIDENCE CHARTER ACT OF 1940"--CODE OF ORDINANCES--CITY OF PROVIDENCE, RHODE ISLAND, ARTICLE II OF CHAPTER 5, SECTION 5-9, ENTITLED "POLICE DEPARTMENT--CREATION; APPOINTMENT, QUALIFICATIONS, COMPENSATION OF COMMISSIONER OF PUBLIC SAFETY."

*It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:*

SECTION 1. Chapter 5, Section 5-9 of the Code of Ordinances--City of Providence (Providence Charter Act of 1940), Article II, entitled "Police Department--Creation; Appointment, Qualifications, Compensation of Commissioner of Public Safety", is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 5-9. Police Department--Creation; Appointment, Qualifications, Compensation of Commissioner of Public Safety.

"There shall be a police department, the head of which shall be the commissioner of public safety who shall be appointed by the mayor with the approval of the city council and shall serve at the pleasure of the mayor. The compensation of said commissioner shall be fixed by the city council."

SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its passage.
