



WHEREAS, The Commissioner of Public Safety is requested to submit a report to the City Council Committee on Ordinances that shall include, but not limited to, the following:

- The number of violations issued by Police Department personnel and/or any other authorized agent empowered to issue violations for the period commencing July 12, 1999 to April 1, 2000, that required a violator to pay the required fine and/or appear before the Municipal Court.
- The number of violation warnings issued by Police Department personnel and/or any other authorized agent empowered to issue violations for the period commencing July 12, 1999 to April 1, 2000.
- Any directives or policy statements associated with the issuance of noise control violations and the general enforcement thereof.
- Any recommendations by the Commissioner or the Chief of Police that will improve or enhance the enforcement of the Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Commissioner of Public Safety is hereby requested to submit a report on the enforcement of the "Noise Control" Ordinance.
