## CHAPTER 1995

No. 540 **AN ORDINANCE** PROVIDING FOR THE SUBMISSION OF CERTAIN  
QUESTIONS TO THE VOTERS OF THE CITY AT A SPECIAL ELECTION  
ON NOVEMBER 10, 1959.

Approved October 16, 1959

### *Be it ordained by the City of Providence:*

Section 1. The Board of Canvassers and Registration is hereby authorized and directed to provide and arrange for a special election to be held in the City of Providence on Tuesday, November 10, 1959 at which election the following questions shall be submitted to the qualified electors of the City of Providence.

1. Shall Chapter 141 of the Public Laws of Rhode Island, approved May 27, 1959 be approved and the City of Providence be authorized to issue bonds pursuant to said Chapter in a sum not exceeding One Million (\$1,000,000) Dollars for School Modernization.

2. Shall Chapter 142 of the Public Laws of Rhode Island, approved May 27, 1959 be approved and the City of Providence be authorized to issue bonds pursuant to said Chapter in a sum not exceeding Three Hundred Thousand (\$300,000) Dollars for improvements to the Water Purification Works in Scituate, Rhode Island.

3. Shall the City of Providence be authorized to issue bonds in a sum not exceeding Four Million Six Hundred Thousand (\$4,600,000) Dollars for a Hurricane Barrier.

Sec. 2. Said election shall be held in conformity with the election laws of the State of Rhode Island, except in the following particulars as authorized by Chapter 3526 of the Public Laws of Rhode Island, approved May 5, 1955, entitled "An Act Excepting Certain Special Elections in the City of Providence from the Election Laws of the State in Certain Respects."

(1) The warrant providing for said referendum shall be issued at least ten (10) days before the date fixed for said referendum and need not be posted as otherwise provided by law, but the same shall be posted by publication in a daily newspaper having local circulation.

(2) The number of polling places to be provided for shall be not less than 3 nor more than 6 for each ward.

(3) The number of officials for each polling place shall be not less than 4 nor more than 8.

(4) The voting hours shall be from 10:00 a. m. to 9:00 p. m.

(5) One check list of voters shall be used at each voting place in lieu of the customary two check lists.

Sec. 3. The City Clerk is directed to transmit to the Secretary of State forthwith upon the passage of this Ordinance, a certified copy thereof, and the Secretary of State is thereupon authorized and requested to place upon the ballot the aforesaid questions.

Sec. 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

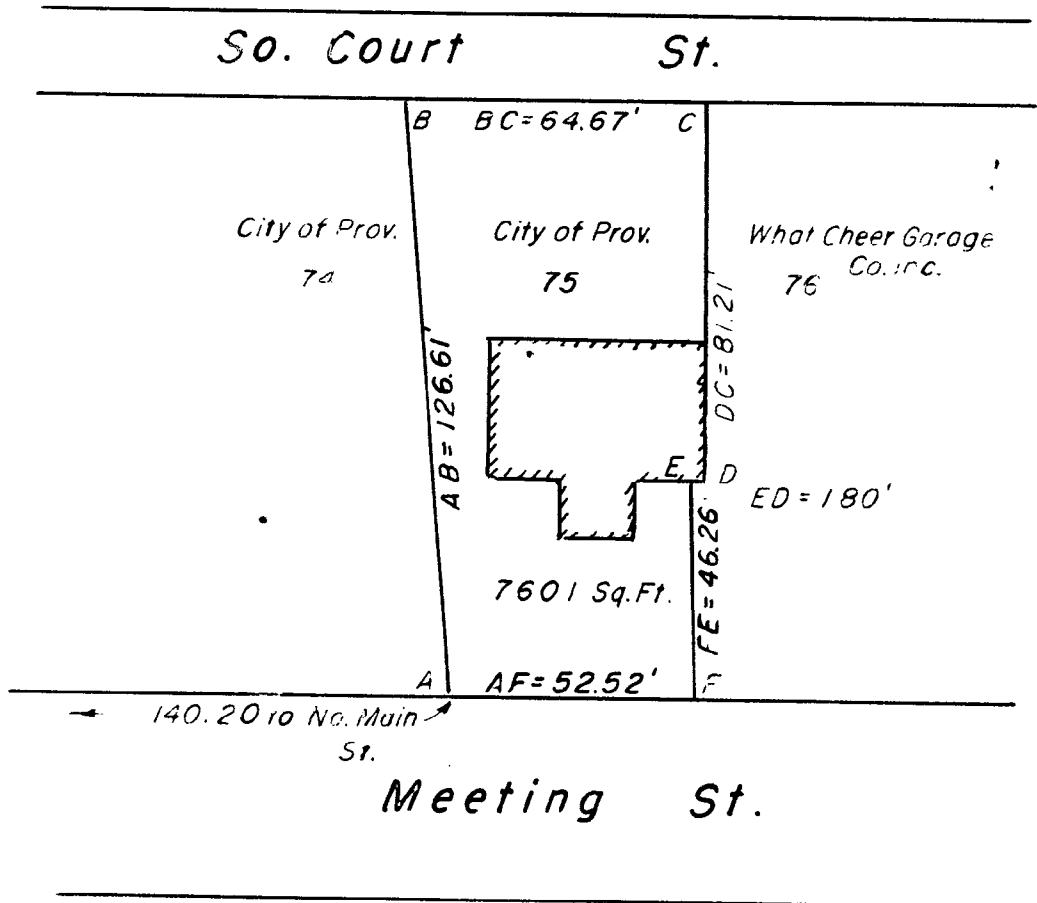
