No. 297

Approved May 23, 1980

WHEREAS, The staff of the Division of Code Enforcement has successfully identified a large number of such violations and referred them to the appropriate authorities for prosecution, and

WHEREAS, The City has attempted to make provision for much more vigorous prosecution of such violations,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Presiding Justices of the State Courts having jurisdiction over such cases be requested to make appropriate additional time and space available on their calendars to hear and expeditiously act on all such cases brought before it by the City of Providence.
