AN ORDINANCE the Water Supply Board

Relative to the Master Lease for

Approved April 29, 1996

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

Section 1. That the City of Providence enter into a lease purchase agreement to finance the purchase of the following list of capital items and improvements totalling One Million Five Thousand Dollars (\$1,005,000) plus administrative fees, as listed on the attached proposed financing list, identified as Exhibit A.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect retroactive to July 1, 1995.

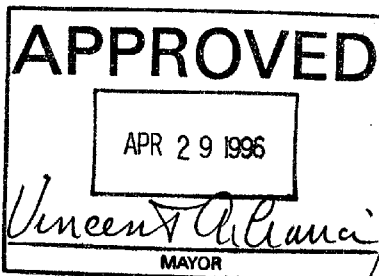
