

Dear Councilman Payne:

Under date of June 10, I received a copy of a petition from the Department of the City Clerk covering the abandonment of Fountain Street from Franklin Street northeasterly to Greene Street. In this section of Fountain Street, we have relaid a new special fire service main as well as a regular low service main and under no circumstances can the street be abandoned.

I do not think it was the intent of the Redevelopment Agency to abandon the entire width of Fountain Street between Franklin Street and Greene Street. They do plan to establish new street lines in Fountain Street so it is my belief that the proper way to present this to your Committee would be to show the abandonment of the section of Fountain Street and at the same time, present the new street lines which would enable the City Council to receive the new street. If it is handled in this manner, the recently laid water mains would be located within the new street lines.



Gentlemen:

The subject referral received consideration by the City Plan Commission at a meeting held on Tuesday, July 30, 1968.

This referral is a request for the abandonment of that portion of Fountain Street from Franklin Street northeasterly to Greene Street.


On an inspection and photographic survey it was determined that the section of Fountain Street in question is flanked by two parking lots on the southeast side and by the new Regency Apartment Building on the northwest side.

Since the Providence Redevelopment Agency owned both sides of Fountain Street as it existed, and since the requested abandonment is for the purpose of repositioning the street approximately 20 feet in width to the northwest and rededicating a new and improved Fountain Street,

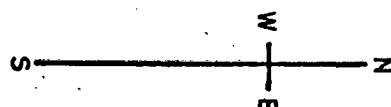

Gentlemen:

The subject referral received consideration by the City Plan Commission at a meeting held on Tuesday, September 10, 1968.

This referral is a request to abandon that unmarked and unimproved public right of way located on Assessor's Plat 109 commencing at the easterly line of Hauxhurst Street where Hauxhurst Street forms a right angle with itself, and extending for 113.34 feet in an easterly direction and measuring 10.54 feet in width.

On an inspection and photographic survey it was determined that the right of way described in the petition is vacant and overgrown with weeds and debris; a new church is in the final stages of construction on the lot adjacent to it. The remainder of the neighborhood is residential and in fair to good condition.

Since this strip of land is no longer useful as a right of way and has become a catch-all for trash and debris, and since there are no plans in this Department for its use,

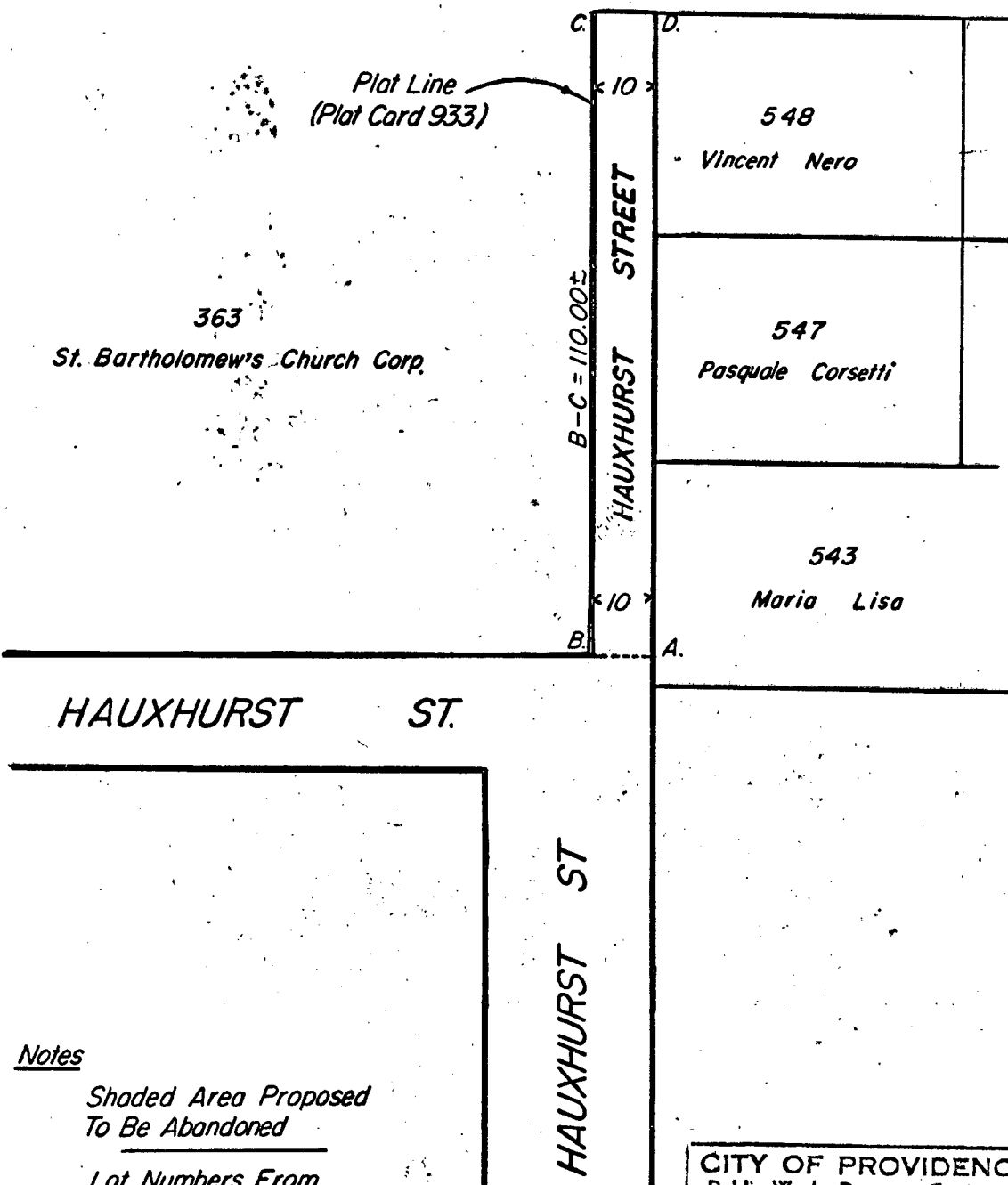

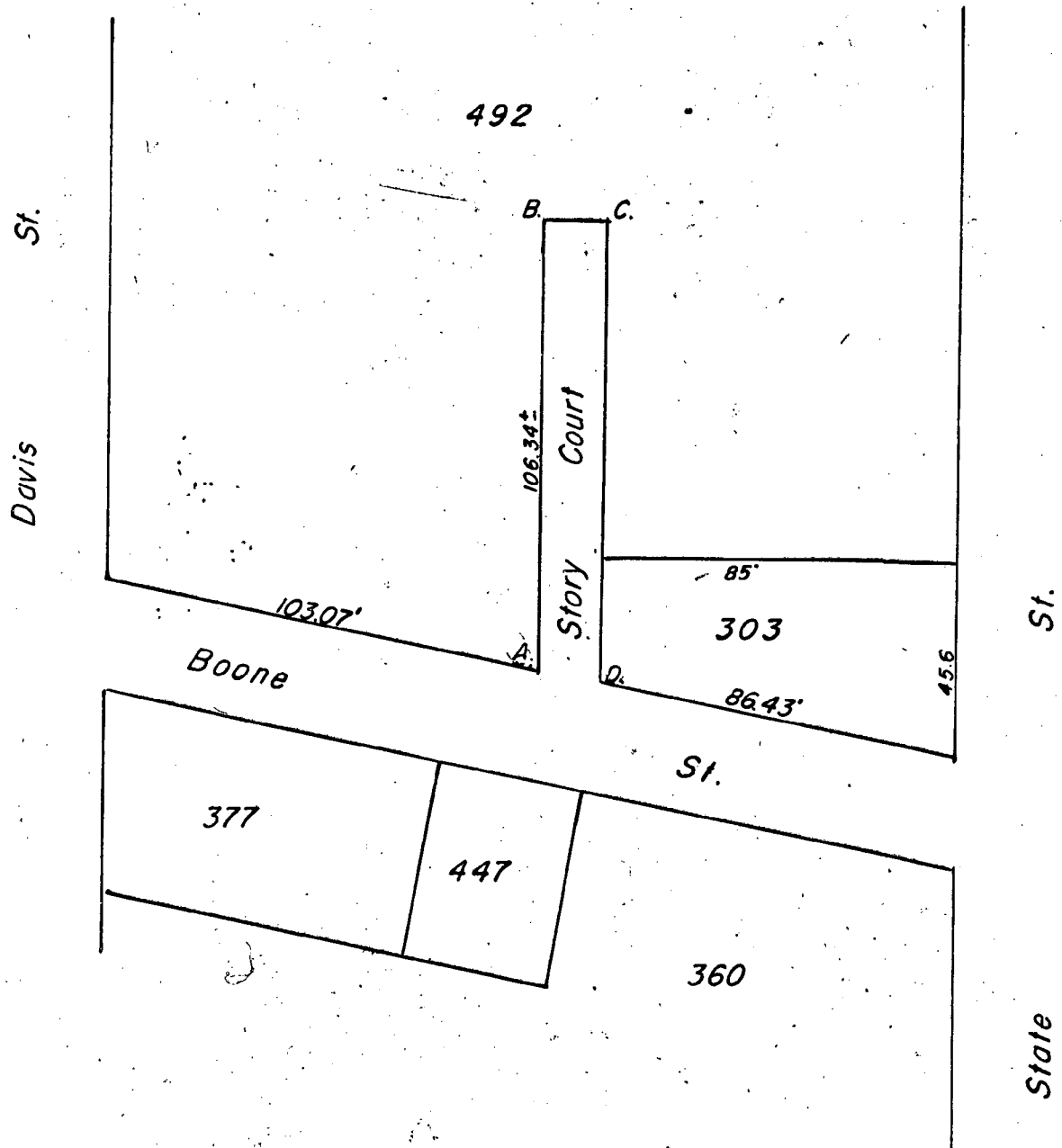
