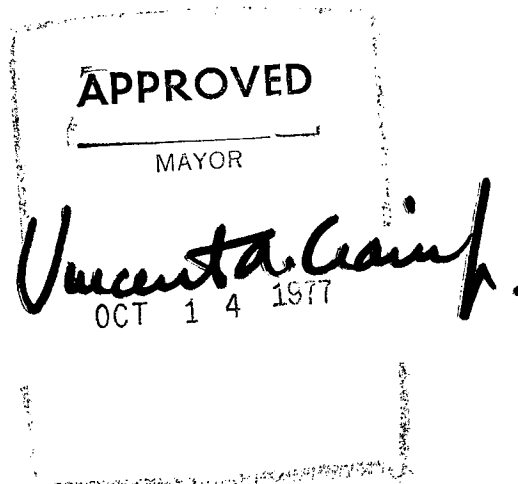

Dear Mrs. Mendonca:

The Honorable City Council requested recently (through resolution) that this office consider assigning a school crossing guard at the intersection of Sackett and Melrose Sts.

I wish to report that the Police Department Traffic Bureau has conducted a survey of this intersection which is equipped with a 4-way stop sign. A total of 9 children were found to be crossing here.

A crossing guard is regularly posted a block away from the above location at the corner of Sackett and Hamilton Sts. It is the opinion of the police and the above crossing guard that the children now using Sackett and Melrose Sts. could safely walk one additional block and be served by the crossing guard.

I concur with this opinion.
