To the Honorable the City Council of Providence

Gentlemen:

I have the honor to report to your Honorable Body on the subject of stationing a crossing guard at Laurel Hill and Union Avenues. As requested by your Honorable Body, a study of conditions at this location was made by the Traffic Bureau. The recommendations of the Director of the Traffic Bureau were that the stationing of a crossing guard at this location is not warranted at this time.

The investigating officer conferred with Sister Cecilia, principal of St. Bartholomew's School prior to his field inspections. Between 8:00 and 8:30 A.M. and between 3:00 and 3:30 P.M. some fifteen to twenty pupils cross at this intersection. At noon an average of three pupils cross. On Tuesdays and Wednesdays at 2:30 P.M. and again at 4:00 P.M. pupils from Gladstone Street School in the city of Cranston cross on their way to religious instructions.

The traffic at this intersection is light to medium at these times.

After careful consideration of the above factors, I concur with the recommendations of the Director of the Traffic Bureau. However, I shall cause another survey to be made in the fall of this year to determine the need at that time.
