

Gentlemen:

The Providence Redevelopment Agency in accordance with the provisions of Paragraph 11 of Chapter 1575 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, approved October 18, 1963, and Title 45, Chapter 31-33 (inclusive) of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, hereby reports concerning the proposed sale of real property within the Weybosset Hill Project No. R. I. R-7.

The Agency proposes to sell a certain parcel of land situated within the Weybosset Hill Project to the Armenian Evangelical Church of Providence. Said parcel of land has been delineated on the attached map and is comprised of 14,760 square feet, which is to be sold for a total sales price of \$33,800.

The redeveloper would utilize this area for off-street parking and will improve the land in conformity with the controls of the redevelopment plan.


