



# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

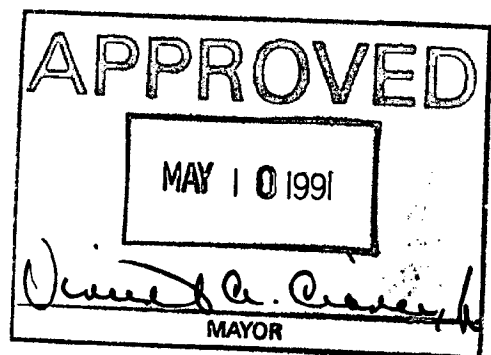

*Approved* May 10, 1991

RESOLVED, That the President of the City Council is hereby authorized to create an Education Committee consisting of five (5) Members of the City Council, one (1) representative from the Mayor's Office to be selected by the Mayor, one (1) representative from the School Administration Office to be selected by the Superintendent of Schools, two (2) School Board Members to be selected by the School Board, one (1) American Federation of Teachers Union - Teacher representative to be selected by the Union and two (2) Parents to be selected by the community-wide Parents Teachers Association, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this Committee will be an Advisory one for the purpose of promoting communications on school issues, with the goal of promoting quality education in the City of Providence.
